## Minutes of the Board of Trustees Reclamation District No. 537 June 10, 2021

Pursuant to the foregoing consent and the notice thereof, duly and regularly posted and given to all members of the Board of Trustees, and by-laws of said District, a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of Reclamation District No. 537 was called to order by President William Mattos on Thursday, June 10, 2021, at 9:08 am in-person and via Teams online meeting.

### 1. <u>Meeting Attendance:</u>

Meeting attended by Trustees William Mattos, Dan Ramos, Ross Peabody, Ray Yeung, and Thomas Ramos. Attendees included the following staff and RD 537 Consultants: General Manager Kyle Lang, Dustin Dumars, Tina Anderson, Nichole Leonard, Austin Cho. One member of the public, Rich Yeung, also attended the meeting.

## 2. <u>Approval of Agenda:</u>

Trustee Dan Ramos moved to approve the Agenda. Trustee Peabody seconded and the motion carried 5-0-0.

 Approval of minutes of the Board meeting of April 9, 2021 and May 28, 2021: Trustee Thomas Ramos moved to approve the minutes of the regular board meeting of April 9, 2021 and the special board meeting of May 28, 2021. Trustee Ray Yeung seconded and the motion carried 5-0-0.

#### 4. District Finances:

- a. <u>Current status of District finances</u>
   Trustee Mattos to work with the State Lands Commission regarding the return of funds for 827. Dustin Dumars to follow up on outstanding hand bills.
- b. Wire Transfers

Trustee Dan Ramos made a motion to transfer funds from Yolo County to the District's account. Trustee Peabody seconded and the motion carried 5-0-0.

- 5. <u>Public Comment:</u> No public comments were made.
- <u>Discussion on 2021-2022 Budget:</u> Dustin Dumars presented the budget proposed for fiscal year 2021-22 (see attached).
  - a. <u>Consideration of Resolution 2021-06-01 Adopting Assessment Rate for year 2021-2022</u> <u>for RD 537 Elkhorn Basin Benefit Assessment Area</u> Trustee Peabody made a motion to accept Resolution 2021-06-01 Adopting Assessment Rate for year 2021-2022 for RD 537 Elkhorn Basin Benefit Assessment Area. Trustee Yeung seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0-0.
  - b. <u>Consideration of Resolution 2021-06-02 Requesting Collection of Charges on Yolo County</u> <u>Tax Roll for RD 537 Elkhorn Basin Benefit Assessment Area</u> Trustee Peabody made a motion to accept Resolution 2021-06-02 Trustee Yeung

seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0-0.

- <u>Consideration of Certification of Assessment for RD 537</u> Trustee Peabody made a motion to accept Resolution 2021-06-01. Trustee Dan Ramos seconded the motion and it carried 5-0-0.
- 7. <u>MBK updates:</u>
  - a. Lower Elkhorn Setback Levee Update
  - b. Pump Station Update

Construction on the pump station has begun and should be completed next year.

c. Interior Drainage Ditch Update

The interior drainage project is proceeding and should be complete next year.

- Detention Basin Management
   No update on the agreement for RD 537 to manage the detention basin. Tina
   Anderson to follow up with Dan Tibbitts regarding the District mowing the area.
- d. CAMU Update
  - Metal Building Bid Results no update. The site of the metal building has been moved slightly and the drainage plan has been changed from rock to routed inlets.
  - ii. Amend Contract with SAFCA (subcommittee to amend SAFCA contract) Tina Anderson reported the Amendment should be coming in the next day or so and will include funding for outstanding bills and a small amount to deal with coordination with agencies that may come up
- e. FMAP Update

was initially anticipated.

- i. Consideration of Resolution 2021-06-03 to authorize William Mattos as the President to execute documentation for FMAP 2022. Trustee Dan Ramos made the motion to adopt the resolution. Trustee Peabody seconded and the motion carried 5-0-0.
- ii. Consideration of Resolution 2021-06-04 to Accept Funds under 2022 FMAP Trustee. Dan Ramos made a motion to adopt the resolution. Trustee Yeung seconded and the motion carried 5-0-0.
- iii. Results of DWR Inspection
   DWR's still has the area as three districts, so the District has 3 inspection reports (537,785 and 827).
- iv. Spring/Summer Maintenance

The District will perform some rodent control and vegetation debris removal ahead of the Fall inspection. The District will also begin addressing levee encroachments.

- Approve Filing CEQA Notice of Exemptions for Maintenance Work: Trustee Peabody made a motion to adopt the CEQA NOE resolution 2021-06-05 for maintenance of the levees and ditches. Trustee Dan Ramos seconded and the motion
- carried 5-0-0.
  9. <u>Update on Oroville Lawsuit Subpoena:</u> Austin Cho reported that the legal case is moving forward but additional time has been requested. The deadline is now July 12. At this time the budget has not changed from what

### 10. WSAFCA Update:

Trustee Thomas Ramos reported that the president's budget has been released and there is funding for WSAFCA Federal projects if Congress retains the provision. Leveed urban areas will have to have a 200-year level of protection, though the Legislature may extend the deadline. It is possible that USACE might take over some of the projects WSAFCA is administering. This might include future work along W. Capitol and Avenue and the Bypass.

## 11. RD 827 and RD 785 Billing from Jim Nolan:

Trustee Peabody is continuing to follow up on the invoices from Jim Nolan. Clarification has been requested in writing prior to payment of invoices regarding billings for both 785 and 827 and items billed after the dissolution of those Districts.

Austin Cho reported there are some boxes of files remaining pertaining to RD 785 and 827. General Manager Kyle Lang has coordinated and arranged for secure storage space until the files can be moved to the Corp Yard Building, once complete.

## 12. Manager's Report:

Trustee Mattos and General Manager Kyle Lang to review drainage plan next week. The District installed signage regarding trespassing and will be installing further signage to deter trespassing and littering of levee bank.

The District received a 20-foot cargo container for flood fight supplies. The remaining supplies from RD 785 and 827 will be added and the supplies will be replaced if used. The container will be stored at the Elkhorn Fire Department until it can be moved to the Corp Yard area.

Trustee Mattos proposed changing District staff member Calen Lang to non-exempt to better track the District's expenditures, beginning July 1, 2021.

Tina Anderson to coordinate mowing with David Pesavento at DWR regarding maintenance of the Yolo Bypass Levee.

## 13. Informational Items:

The District will begin working on a proposal to SAFCA for mowing or discing the Detention Basin with their own equipment and labor.

Tina Anderson reported that as the District is now eligible in PL 84-99, the District can begin to plan their SWIF strategy to address levee items rated unacceptable in the USACE PIR.
